A Product Collection Drive is another way to get individuals involved during your United Way Campaign and can provide fun, light-hearted competition between different areas of your organization. Collection drives can support United Way directly or help one of our funded partners collect much needed items.

What items do we collect?

There are a variety of collection drives that help United Way meet the needs of our programs and initiatives, including Tools for School, Coats for Kids & Families, Period Promise, and Hygiene Kits.

Tools for School (June – August)

Tools for School accepts new and unused:

- Backpacks
- 1" 2" Binders
- Coiled notebooks
- Lined paper

- Exercise books

<u>Coats for Kids & Families</u> (October – February)

Coats for Kids & Families accepts clean, gently used, outgrown, and new:

- Men's winter coats
- Women's winter coats
- Children's winter coats
- Toques, mitts, and scarves

- Snow pants (adult and children's sizes)
- Winter boots
- Insulated work wear (men's and women's)
- Insulated work boots

Period Promise (Year-Round)

Period Promise accepts **new and unopened**:

- Tampons (all sizes)
- Sanitary pads (all sizes)
- Daily liners (all sizes)
- Menstrual cups (all sizes)

*All products must be in their original box/packaging. Disposable products are preferred.

Hygiene Kits (Year-Round)

Hygiene Kits accepts new and unused:

- Band-Aids (box of ~30)
- Bars of soap (70 to 100g)
- Deodorant (50 to 70g)
- Lotion (150 to 250ml)
- Shampoo (200 to 400ml)
- Toothpaste (80 to 100ml)
- Toothbrushes

- Vaseline/Lip balm (6 to 8g)
- Boxes of tampons/pads
- Disposable razors
- Combs
- Brushes
- Ziplock bags
- Socks (thermal/spring cotton)
- Baby wipes
- Baby shampoo
- Children's toothpaste
- Children's toothbrushes
- Children's socks
